Total Federal Funding

All Grants by State Fiscal Year

- \$33.5 million in SFY 2015
- \$29 million in sub-awards
- Since SFY 2003 Yearly amounts ranged from a low of \$28.7 million to a high of \$117.9 million in SFY 2013.



Project Level Spending

All Grants

- Public Assistance grants to recover from declared disasters
- Hazard Mitigation
- Statewide and Regional Planners
- Statewide and Regional Training and Exercise
- State and Local Emergency Management
- State and Local Emergency Response

 - Mass Care
 - Hazard Planning
 - Law Enforcement counter-terrorism, information sharing and emergency management

- Dedicated funding towards active assailant events for emergency medical response in light of recent events such as Boston Marathon bombing
- Local set-aside for Interoperability across all response fields.
