MSDE Grant Process

- Competitive and Discretionary Grant Process
 - Our office seeks new funding from various sources such as Grants.gov, Ed.gov, National Science Foundation, and Education Grants Alert;
 - Our Agency has 10 divisions within and we seek various funds for many programs/projects for MSDE to provide support to the LEAs;
 - Once a funding source is located to support a project/program, we contact the appropriate division to begin the process of submitting a grant proposal;
