- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is the U.S. government's principal agency
- for protecting the health of all Americans and providing essential human services,
- especially for those who are least able to help themselves.




HHS Grants in Perspective

- HHS awards approximately 60% of the Federal government's grant dollars, more than all other federal agencies combined
- HHS non-discretionary grants programs such as Medicaid, State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP), and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) are the largest such programs and provide a total of approximately \$600 billion annually to over 80 million Americans
