Total Federal Funding

All Grants by State Fiscal Year

- \$42.7 million in SFY 2014
- \$35.1 million in sub-awards
- Since SFY 2003 Yearly amounts ranged from a low of \$28.7 million to a high of \$117.9 million in SFY 2013.



Project Level Spending

All Grants

- Public Assistance grants to recover from declared disasters
- Hazard Mitigation
- Statewide and Regional Planners
- Statewide and Regional Training and Exercise
- State and Local Emergency Management
- State and Local Emergency Response



MEMA – A Center for Preparedness Excellence

- Implemented the Maryland Emergency Preparedness Program (MEPP), November 2013
- Expanded Training and Exercise Division to prepare for all hazards in each region of Maryland
- Maryland ranked in the top category for best prepared states to respond to an emergency in 2012



Meeting the Homeland Security Preparedness Goal

- Focus on identifying and funding capability needs including but not limited to:
 - Interoperability
 - Mass Care
 - Personal Protective Equipment
 - Law Enforcement Information Sharing (MCAC)



Recent Initiatives – Furthering Preparedness Goals

- Dedicated funding towards active assailant events for emergency medical response in light of recent events such as Boston Marathon bombing
- Local set-aside for the Statewide Interoperability Executive Committee to roll out MD FiRST
