FEMA Grant Programs (	<b>Top 5</b> )

Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP)	Provides funding to states, territories and local governments to prevent, protect against, respond to, mitigate, and recover from potential terrorist attacks and other hazards.
Emergency Management Performance Grant Program (EMPG)	Provides resources to assist state, local, and tribal governments in preparing for all hazards, thereby ensuring the protection of life and property.
Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program (AFG)	Provides funding to fire departments and EMS organizations to enhance their ability to protect the health and safety of the public and first-responder personnel.
Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)	Provides funding for eligible mitigation activities that reduce disaster losses and protect life and property from future disaster damages.
Disaster Declarations	Provides financial or direct assistance to individuals and families whose property has been damaged or destroyed as a result of a federally-declared disaster, and whose losses are not covered by insurance.
