CURRENT POSITION FY16

- \$11.6 Billion total Federal Funds to Maryland Government = 32% State Budget
- Federal funds budget composition: 85% comes from US Department of Health & Human Services, US Department of Transportation, & US Department of Agriculture
- Single Audit Findings Ratio (in 2014) per billion is 1.18


- FFY13 MD Per Capita Taxes Paid = \$10,398, Rank #7 behind New York



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FEDERAL FUNDS ACCOUNT FOR ALMOST A THIRD OF THE FY 2016 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE STATE




Funds Uses:

- Funds for entitlements, programs and state agency operations
- Main programs are Medicaid; Education and Housing
- Large majority of funds are pass through benefits to individuals
- Facing substantial budget pressures from federal government




DISTRIBUTION OF POPULATION BY STATE FOR FY2014 (000s)







TOTAL FEDERAL SPENDING ON SELECTED GRANTS FY2014















FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY TYPE OF GRANT- MEDICAID








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FY2014 Per Capita Federal Spending by Function – Transportation





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FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY FUNCTION - AGRICULTURE



FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY FUNCTION - EDUCATION











FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY FUNCTION - EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING










FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY FUNCTION — COMMUNITY & REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT










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
FY2014 PER CAPITA FEDERAL SPENDING BY FUNCTION — INCOME SECURITY AND SOCIAL SERVICE























