


SGR's Funded Grant Framework



Trends in Federal Grant Funding




Federal Government obligated \$1.13T for grants in FY2022 (USAspending.gov)







CDC Drug Free Communities

- Community-based coalitions that are non-profits (501c3 status)
- Representatives from 12 Sectors
- Request no more than \$125,000/year
- Secure 100% match from non-federal sources
- Jan- March

Rural Communities Opioid Response Program – Overdose Response

- Nonprofits, Education, States, etc.
- Multi-year HRSA initiative
- Reduce morbidity and mortality of substance use disorder
- High-risk rural communities/ High-risk populations
- Jan 2023

Health & Equity

2023 Empowering Communities to Deliver and Sustain Evidence-Based Chronic Disease Self-Management Education Programs

- Nonprofits, government, schools, etc.
- \$600,000
- Develop capacity for, deliver, and sustain evidence-based self-management education and support programs among older adults and adults with disabilities
- Social Determinants of Health
- Jan 2023

Community Services

USDA Learning & Telemedicine

- Government, Federally-recognized Tribes, Non and For-profits, Consortia of eligible entities
- Broadband facilities, Audio, video and interactive video equipment, Computer hardware, Instructional programming that is a capital asset, Technical assistance and instruction for using eligible equipment
- Fall/ Spring

HUD FY 2022 Choice Neighborhoods Implementation

- Cities, Housing Authorities
- Housing, People, Neighborhoods
- Planning-\$500K; Implementation- \$50M
- Jan 2023

Education

USDA Farm to School

- Nonprofits, public entities, schools, etc.
- Make local food and agricultural education available to child nutrition program participants through grants, research, technical assistance, and training
- \$100,000-\$500,000
- Jan 2023

Dept Ed Promise Neighborhoods

- Multi-sectoral; \$6M
- Priority 1: Strengthening Cross-Agency Coordination and Community Engagement to Advance Systemic Change.
- Priority 2: Increasing Postsecondary Education Access, Affordability, Completion, and Post-Enrollment Success.
- Priority 3: Evidence-Based Activities to Support Academic Achievement
