






SGR's Funded Grant Framework





What is the Go/ No-Go Framework?




"Decision making is the process of making choices by identifying a decision, gathering information, and assessing alternative resolutions. Using a *step-by-step* decision-making process can help you make more deliberate, thoughtful decisions by organizing relevant information and defining alternatives."

Go/ No-Go Framework





3 Types of Questions



- Deal-Breakers
- Fit
- Strategy

Deal-Breaker Questions



- Eligibility
 - Can we apply?
- Core Capabilities
 - Is this the FOCUS of our work?
- Deadline
 - Do we have enough time?
- Award Amount
 - How much money is available?
 - How many grants are available?



Fit Questions

- Project Alignment
 - Does our project address their priorities <u>and</u> does the grant meet our needs?
- Organizational Fit
 - Have they funded similar organizations?
- Geographic Fit
 - Have they funded our service area?
- **Financial Fit**
 - Is it enough money?





Strategy Questions


- Readiness
 - Do we have the resources to apply, implement, and manage?
- Impact
 - What will we gain?
 - What will we lose?
- Competitiveness
 - What is our experience?
 - How will it be scored?






Ex 1. Go/ No-Go Framework






Ex 2. Go/ No-Go Framework
