

Establishment of Quality Service Management Offices



Quality Service Management Offices (QSMOs) were created by OMB Memo M-19-16 (April 2019) to improve agency mission delivery though the use of efficient, effective, and modern shared services.

OMB designated HHS as the Grants Quality Service Management Office (QSMO) in January 2021.

Challenges for Fed-wide Grants Management:

Complex

150+ grants management IT solutions, 50 awarding agencies, 1500+ grant programs

Expensive

\$1T+ grants awarded annually, impacting all sectors of the American economy

Aging

Fed-wide grants management systems landscape is large, aging, customized, and costly

The Grants QSMO offers federal awarding agencies shared IT solutions & services that empower agencies & grant recipients to efficiently & effectively deliver on the \$1T+ annual grants mission.






