

Public Safety Training Example

In many states, 911 services and operations are managed at the county level. Counties often use varying different technologies to achieve similar objectives and services. The State of Montana is awarding grants to Montana counties to decrease user-errors and increase efficiency in 911 service delivery. The objective of the grant program is to ensure all public safety personnel are comprehensively trained on utilizing their applicable 911 technologies. Counties may use grant funds for training-related activities such as: creating online learning modules, hiring private-sector trainers to


conduct training workshops, or design in-person training curriculum.

School Violence Prevention Grant Example

The State of Oregon is implementing a 4-year grant program to increase school safety using evidence-based solutions to prevent violence against schools, staff, and students and ensure a positive school climate. Allowable activities include: developing and operating technology solutions such as anonymous reporting systems for threats of school violence (including mobile telephone applications, hotlines, websites, or other school safety technology solutions) OR developing and implementing multidisciplinary threat assessment and intervention teams.
